Cllr Middleton updated Councillors issues previously arranged with the lateness of Arriva buses in Madeley, Sutton Hill and Woodside causing residents to be late for school, college, and work. Cllr Middleton confirmed that Arriva have introduced an earlier service to ensure that this does not happen, introduced additional buses to the routes and have potentially rerouted the X10 service to Shrewsbury from to include the Madeley area from September 2023.

Cllr White said that when Arriva have staffing difficulties, they always change the services to Sutton Hill, although the Telford & Wrekin Council No. 100 and No. 101 bus services have help with this. Cllr Middleton confirmed that if the bus is highly used, it is usually the bus that Arriva remove. Cllr White asked about the longevity of the Telford & Wrekin Council No. 100 and No. 101 buses. Cllr Watling said that this had not yet been discussed in Cabinet.

Cllr England asked how Councillor reclaim their Election Expenses by 1 |June 2023. Cllr Watling confirmed that for the Labour Group, this would be done via the campaign representative.
